So you are going to see your doctor.....

1) When you need to see your doctor, phone up to make an appointment.



2) Go to your doctors surgery on the day of your appointment. It's ok to take a friend or carer with you.

3) Go to the reception desk and let them know that you are there.



4) You will be asked to sit and wait for the doctor.



5) When the doctor is ready you will get called through.

It's ok to go in on your own or with a friend.



6) The doctor will ask you what is wrong with you.



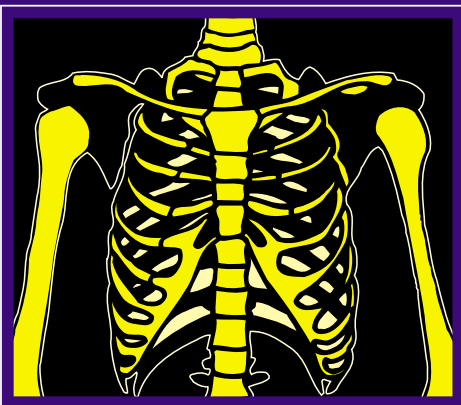
7) The doctor may want to do some tests. The doctor might ask the nurse to do them.



8) You might have a blood test, physical check, weight and height check.



10) Some doctors will visit you at home,
**BUT ONLY IF YOU ARE TOO ILL TO GET
TO THE SURGERY.**
